

## ***2010 Florida TSA National Conference Polo Shirt Design Contest***

Florida TSA is seeking Polo Shirt designs for the 2010 Official FL TSA Baltimore National Conference Polo Shirt. This is a design that is printed on the front of the shirt (left side of shirt). This is NOT a large design intended for the back of the polo. (See Sample.)

Participants are limited to six (6) individuals per chapter, and one (1) entry per member. In the event that more entries are submitted than allowed, the “extra” entries will be removed from competition randomly.

### **The Guidelines for Designs are as follows:**

1. Finished Design must be submitted on a CD or DVD or Thumb-drive, which can be read by a PC or MAC system. (CD, DVD, or Thumb-drive will not be returned.)
2. A vector format image is preferred. (example: Adobe Illustrator)
3. Raster designs may be submitted; however, the print size must be 5” X 7” or larger. No entry may exceed 8” X 10”. Resolution must be at least 300 dpi. (example: Adobe Photoshop)
4. Finished size of the design will be no larger than 8” by 10” (horizontal format). This size is for draft printing purposes.
5. The design must be original and reflect, interpret, or in some way communicate that it is the shirt of a FL TSA member visiting Baltimore.
6. No more than four (4) spot colors may be used in the design.
7. Design file must be delivered for printing (CMYK).
8. A designer’s sheet of notes must be supplied with the design. The “designer’s notes” must be no more than one typed page using type of least 10 point. Any and all clip art or other non-original art must be identified in the notes. The source of said clip art must be clearly noted. Hand written notes will not be considered and typed notes over one full page will be a disqualification for the entry. (These notes must be included on the CD and should either be in a MS Word format or a .pdf format.)

### **Submission**

1. All entries (CD, DVD, or Thumb-drive) must be labeled with the Designer’s name, Chapter Advisor’s name, School name and mailing address.
2. All entries must be submitted to Mr. Harold Miner, FL TSA Executive Director, during the State Conference 2010 at the time and place listed in the conference program.

**Your design entry must meet all of the following requirements or it will not be considered:**

1. Failure to follow all of the guidelines established above.
2. By entering this contest the participant releases any claim to the design now and in the future. Any profits from the use of the design (real or perceived) are the sole property of Florida Technology Student Association and Foundation, Inc.
3. Your entry must be original and not violate third-party rights including, copyrights, trademarks and any other intellectual property rights.
4. Use of the Florida TSA Logo (patch) and/or the Alligon are not required but are allowed to be used and not considered to be a copyright infringement.
5. Florida TSA reserves the right to make any adjustments to the winning design.
6. The winning entrant will receive a complimentary 2010 National Conference Registration. (This prize may be transferred to another member of the chapter if the need arises.)
7. All entries become the property of Florida TSA, Inc. and will not be returned after judging.
